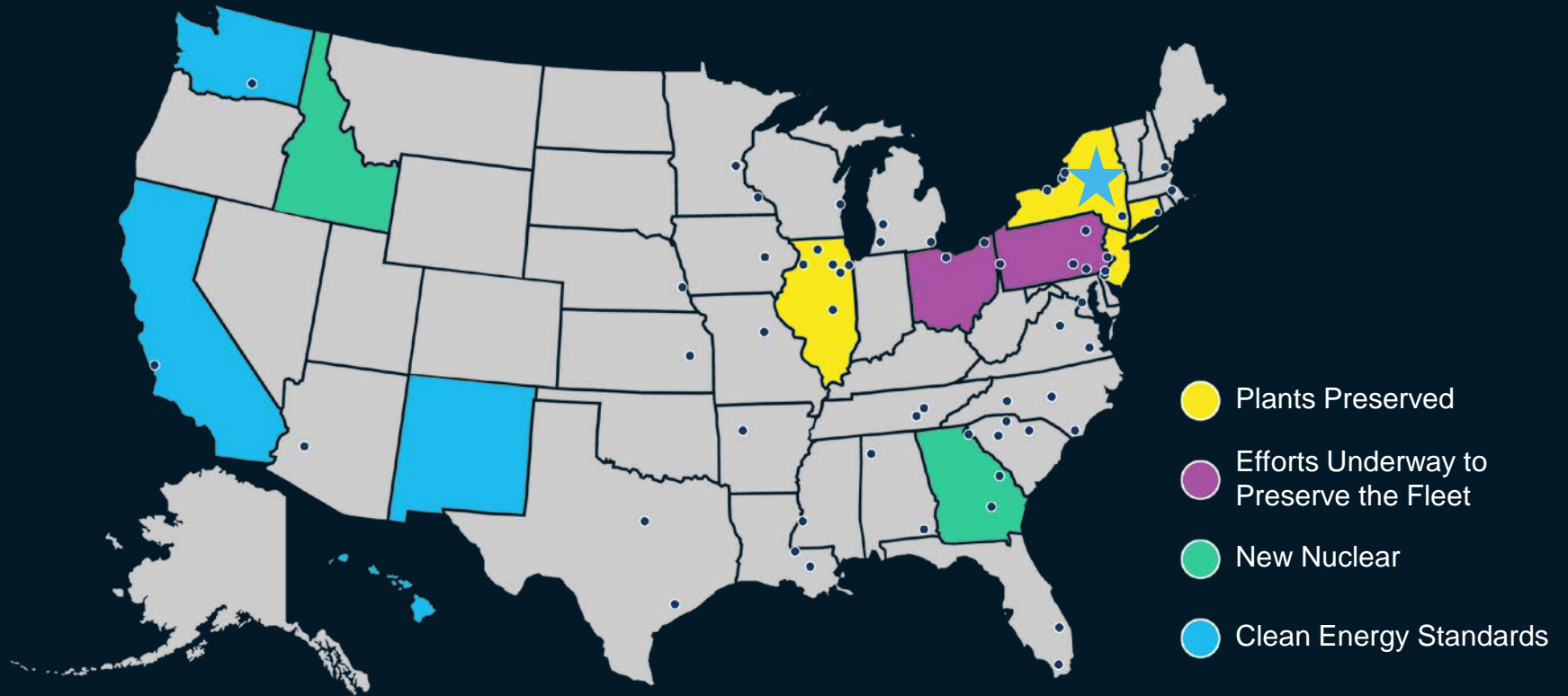

Nuclear Energy Leadership Act (NELA)



- PPAs: Update law to extend maximum length of federal PPAs from 10 to 40 years
- Establishes a pilot program for federal nuclear PPA to exceed 10 years
- Authorizes a fast neutron-capable research facility
- HALEU: Establishes a program to provide a minimum amount from DOE stockpiles, until a long-term domestic supply is developed

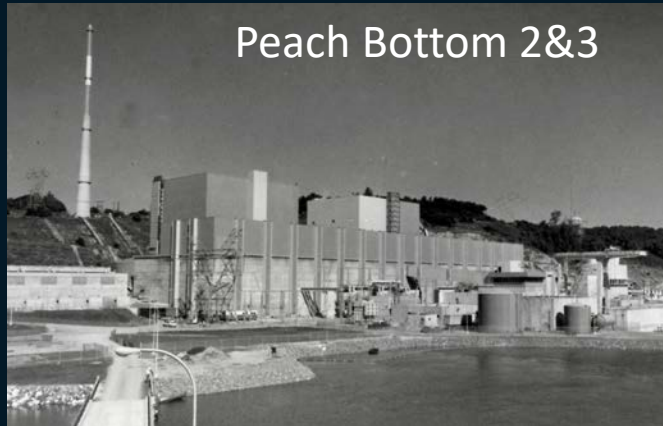
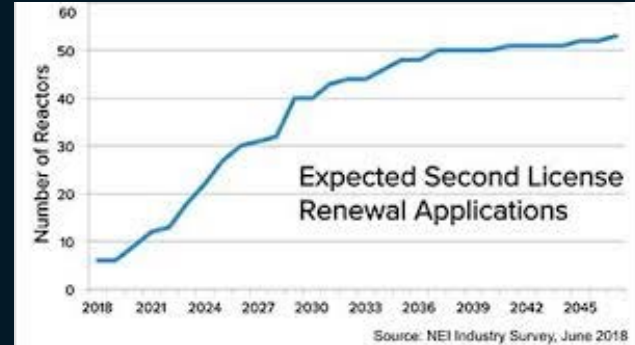
